- * School **Registration Fee of \$100.00** is only **\$50** when paid by October 1, 2021 (non-refundable). Schools must register by October 1 so we can build their school portal for them to upload their students' events. After October 27, events can be dropped but can not be added.
- * Cost: **\$50.00/Student** competing in-person & virtual due upon arrival.
Cost: **\$25.00/Student** competing only in virtual events due October 27.
- * **\$10** charge for pre-registered guests and sponsors. There will be a gate charge of **\$15** per person for un-registered guests. **No charge for Judges.**
- * **Competition age** — Students who attain their **8th** birthday by **Dec. 31, 2021** and who have not attained their **13th** birthday by the same date.
- * A noon meal on Friday will be provided for your convenience at no extra charge. A concessions stand will be available throughout both days. (Candy, chips, soft drinks, nachos, hotdogs, etc.)
- * All Uploaded Events must be completed by **October 27, 2021**. All art/craft events that will be delivered to 4565 Bemiss Road, Valdosta, GA must be set up by November 1, 2021. Shipped art/craft events will need to be shipped by October 27, in order for us to have them set up by Nov. 1 for the judges.
- * Those who will be attending in person must check-in on Friday, November 12, 2021, **from 8:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m.**
- * **Competition** starts on **Friday @ 10:00 a.m.** ending with a Rally & Awards @ 4:00 p.m. The Rally & Awards program will be on Lighthouse Christian School's Facebook Page (www.lcsministry.org)
- * Follow the **ISC guidelines** for all events. Please **pray** for the Junior Convention.

DEEP SOUTH JR. CONVENTION TIMELINE STEPS TO SUCCESS

SECURE INFORMATION in a three-ring binder for easy access:

1. Print this document for reference and place in the front of your notebook.
2. Print a copy of the Student Registration Form for each eligible student.
3. Print a copy of the Volunteer Convention Judges Form and give to each potential adult.
4. Go to the ACE website (www.aceministries.com) and print the guidelines for each event.



EARLY BIRD GETS THE WORM!

At a Parent/Teacher Orientation at the beginning of the school year share with the parents the advantages of student convention and ask your parents for help. Have the parents fill out the **PICTURE/VIDEO PERMISSION FORM** for their student(s).

SELECT EVENTS

BALANCING INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT WITH SCHOOL NEEDS:

1. Give students a copy of the Student Registration Form and have them select their events.
2. Go over with each student their chosen events and if needed add events.
3. Group students in group events.
4. Print or copy rules and judging criteria for each individual by event selected and have them maintain a personal convention preparation notebook or folder.
5. Print judges form as reference to evaluation breakdown for each — use as part of your preparation criteria.
6. By the first of September begin memory work and practice on performance selections.
7. By the first of October finalize necessary paperwork for projects. This is an excellent time to complete permission forms and get signatures from parents.
8. By the middle of October have a special Parent/Teacher's Fellowship to share all your students hard work. Have a special offering to help with expenses.



EVENT REGISTRATION UPLOADING DEADLINE

1. The Registration Form must be Postmark by October 1, 2021. You can register online by going to www.lbcministry.org and click on Jr. Convention Registration.
2. All uploaded events will need to be uploaded by October 27, 2021.
3. Include the following in your registration (take pictures of the following & upload them to your school's portal):
 - a. CF5 Sponsor Registration Forms
 - b. CF6 Permission for Participation (one per student)
 - c. CF8 Parent/Guardian Consent for Student (one per student)
 - d. CF16 Student Convention Screening Form (one per school)
 - e. Judges/Volunteer forms with areas checked



All Uploaded Events can be **uploaded** by October 27, 2021

A student can enter events and not have to be at the convention on Fri., Nov. 12, 2021.
At least one staff member from each school must be present to receive awards and pick up projects. NO Projects will be mailed or returned!
