WHO CAN PARTICIPATE AS A CONTESTANT?

STUDENTS IN CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS & HOME SCHOOLS THAT MEET THE REQUIRED Competition Age:

Students who attain their 8th birthday by Dec. 31, 2024 and who have not attained their 13th birthday by Dec. 31, 2024. Students must attend the entire day of convention to be eligible for any awards.

1. School Registration Fee \$75.00

2. Contestant Fee \$50.00

NUMBER OF ENTRIES

1. In events involving more than four students, the limit is one entry per event per school.
2. In all elimination events a school is allowed three entries per event.
3. In all Athletic events a school is allowed five entries per event.
4. In all other events, a school is allowed six entries per event
5. Each contestant may have only one entry in the same event.
6. A student can enter 14 events plus 3 athletic events for a total of 17 events. Out of the 14 events a student can not enter more than 8 performance events.

MAJOR CHANGE IN COMPETITION

The main purpose of Jr. Convention is to prepare the students for Regional or International competition. The Bible states "Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend." (Proverb 27:17)

All the events that require a Judges' Form in the categories of Academics, Arts/Craft, Music & Platform will be awarded as one event except events in those categories with three or more entries, that event will be awarded separately. In other words, an event with less than three entries would compete with all the other events in that category that has less than three entries. Example: In the Music Category, if there is only one entry in duet, one entry in trio and one entry in ensemble, etc. then awards would be given based on the one that has the highest score in that category regardless of the event.


